## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 2823**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO FLOOD CONTROL MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO.1 (AM/PM CUP 98-0081)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Perris, California, has previously formed special maintenance districts pursuant to the terms of the "Benefit Assessment Act of 1982", being Chapter 6.4 (commencing with Section 54703) of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 5 of the California Government Code of the State of California, said special maintenance districts known and designated as FLOOD CONTROL MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 (hereinafter referred to as the "Maintenance District"); and,

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property within the territory proposed to be annexed to the Maintenance District have filed with the City Clerk their written consent to the proposed annexation without notice and hearing or filing of an Engineer's "Report".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 2. That this legislative body hereby orders the annexation to the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto to the Maintenance District.

Section 3. That all-future proceedings of the Maintenance District, including the levy of all assessments shall be applicable to the territory annexed hereunder.
