A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT FOR THE PERRIS VALLEY ARTS AND ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE (PVAAC) TO RECRUIT AMERICORP VISTA WORKERS

WHEREAS, the Perris Valley Arts and Activities Committee has collaboratively worked with the City of Perris for over 39 years by providing the: 39th Annual Arts Festival, 39th Christmas Hollow Toys Give-A-Way, co-sponsored Black History Month programs (i.e. annual panel discussions, and Black History Month Parade), youth programs, talent shows, and music productions; and

WHEREAS, the Perris Valley Arts and Activities Committee has provided community service programs with 90% volunteerism; and

WHEREAS, the City of Perris wants to continue collaboration with the Perris Valley Arts and Activities Committee to accommodate current needs of the community including a teen mentor program and after school activities for at-risk youth; and

WHEREAS, the City of Perris Valley Arts and Activities Committee will collaboratively use the AmeriCorps*VISTA workers for coordinating youth programs and fund raising; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Perris supports the Perris Valley Arts and Activities efforts to recruit four (4) AmeriCorps*VISTA workers for the purpose of organizing community volunteers, development of collaborative fund raising for youth programs, and expanding youth programs in the City of Perris;
