

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4134

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL ADOPT GPA NO. 08-03-0016, CITY OF PERRIS 2008-2014 HOUSING ELEMENT AND NEGATIVE DECLARATION NO. 2269.

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 65580 requires that every city and county prepare and periodically update its housing element; and

WHEREAS, a series of public workshops were held December 5, 2007, January 2, 2008 and February 20, 2008 to receive input from community stakeholders and residents relative to the Housing Element update; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed and provided input on the draft Housing Element at a Planning Commission public workshop on December 5, 2007, and again at Planning Commission public workshops in January and February, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at such public meeting received comment from all those in attendance wishing to speak; and

WHEREAS, the draft Housing Element was reviewed by the State Department of Housing and Community Development per Government Code Section 65585(b), and has been revised to comply with State housing element law (Article 10.6 of the Government Code), and

WHEREAS, an Initial Study prepared for the draft Housing Element finds that the project could not have significant impacts; therefore, a Negative Declaration has been prepared.

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2008, the Planning Commission recommended adoption of the draft Housing Element and Negative Declaration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Perris, California does hereby recommend, resolve, and certify as follows:

Section 1. The City Council should rescind the Housing Element adopted by City Council resolution on April 4, 2001.

Section 2. That the City Council affirms by this Resolution that the Housing Element adopted on June 10, 2008, is incorporated by reference herein into General Plan 2030.

Section 3. The Negative Declaration has been completed in compliance with Section 15072 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Section 4. The City Council declares that should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences and words of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Resolution.
