Perris, California is Home to the West's Largest Railway History Museum



The City named after a famous railroad engineer is also home to the 70-acre Orange Empire Railway Museum featuring the **West's largest collection** of locomotives, passenger and freight cars, streetcars, and other artifacts dating from the 1870's

The Museum hosts a **number of popular annual events** including a "Day Out With Thomas" featuring Thomas the Tank which draws more than 30,000 visitors

Other activities include birthday parties, field trips, educational classes, mixers and special events such as The Santa Train and Father's Day picnic **which appeal to visitors of all ages**
