

Did YOU Know?

Metrolink Commuter Service is Coming Soon to Perris, California



The \$120 million **Perris Valley Line** will extend Metrolink service to Perris, Riverside and Moreno Valley bringing commuter service to major employment centers as well as providing cities in Riverside County closer access to the Southern California commuter rail network

Anticipated to open in 2012, the 24-mile Perris Valley Line will run parallel to the I-215 Freeway and **two of the four Metrolink stations will be located in Perris**

By 2025 the Perris Valley Line is **anticipated to serve 4,350 riders daily** and cut the projected rush-hour commute time from Riverside in half from 80 minutes to 40 minutes

The new service will ease freeway congestion, **open the Perris Valley to even greater economic development opportunities** and attract more visitors to the easier-to-reach City
