WHEREAS, Moreno Valley College has diligently served the communities of Moreno Valley, Perris and areas of Riverside County since 1991, opening its doors in March 1991 with 3,000 students and now serving 10,000 students as of Fall 2009; and

WHEREAS, Moreno Valley College offers a full complement of lower division courses in liberal arts, sciences, humanities, and basic skills education while offering specialty career technical programs in the allied health sciences and in the public safety training academy; and

WHEREAS, in March 2004 the California Post Secondary Education Commission (CPEC) approved proposals from Riverside Community College District to convert its Moreno Valley and Norco education centers to full college status; and

WHEREAS, in January 2010, following a second comprehensive evaluation, the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) acted to Grant Initial Accreditation to the Moreno Valley Campus to become Moreno Valley College; and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2010, the Board of Governor's for the California Community College system, approved the establishment of Moreno Valley College as the 111th college in the California Community College system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Perris, California hereby recognizes Moreno Valley College as an independent college of the Riverside Community College District and congratulates the entire college community for its success in becoming the 111th college in the California Community college system.
