

74/215 INTERCHANGE PROJECT CONSTRUCTION ALERT

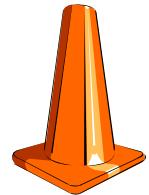
PERRIS – The Riverside County Transportation Commission and project partners continue constructing the 74-215 Interchange (also known as the 4th Street Interchange).

Temporary freeway lane closures will be necessary to allow for roadway paving and relocating the concrete barriers along the center median. As a reminder, the speed limit along the project area has been reduced to **55 mph**. The reduced speed limit will remain in place for the duration of the project.

Closures are required as follows, weather and contractor’s resources permitting:

Closure Activity	Closure Location	Date, Time and Details
Lane Closures	Northbound I-215 between ½ mile south and ½ mile north of Redlands Avenue	Monday, January 30 and Tuesday, January 31 A closure of the inside freeway lane will be required each night from 8 pm to 4 am the following morning. No detour will be required since one travel lane will remain open at all times.
Lane Closures	Southbound I-215 between ½ mile north and ½ mile south of Redlands Avenue	Monday, January 30 and Tuesday, January 31 A closure of the freeway inside lane will be required each night from 9 pm to 5 am the following morning. No detour will be required since at least one travel lane will remain open during this closure.
Speed Limit Reduced	Northbound and Southbound I-215 between ½ mile south of 4 th Street to just south of Perris Blvd	In Effect through the End of Project The freeway speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph . New speed limit signs have been posted. Please be aware that traffic fines increase in the construction zone.

The project will pave the way for better traffic flow, easier access to downtown Perris and improved connections to both north and south Interstate 215. The project will replace the current two-lane bridge over the freeway with an eight-lane bridge, realign freeway ramps, widen streets, replace stop signs with traffic signals, add a sidewalk north of the bridge and build residential sound walls. Throughout construction, please remember to **Slow for the Cone Zone!**
