City of Perris Offer Internet Service Assistance to Students

PERRIS, Calif. (July 16, 2020) —The City of Perris announced the approval of a new E-Learn Program to provide internet service assistance at the City Council meeting on June 9, 2020.

This public service program is designed to assist City of Perris students who have been displaced due to school closures with internet service for no more than three months. This three-month assistance limitation is required under HUD guidelines. Program requirements include:

1. Applicants must be an incorporated City of Perris resident;
2. Applicants cannot exceed 80% of the 2020 HUD income limits for their household size;
3. Households must have at least one currently enrolled K-12 grade and/or college/university student that lives in the home as their primary residence. Proof of current enrollment and primary residence will be required.
4. Payments will be made directly to the internet service provider.

The E-Learn Program provides internet assistance for three months per eligible households after a one-time reallocation of \$16,000 unexpended Public Service funds from the 2019-2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). Under the current guidelines

established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), these funds must be expended by July 30, 2020.
